Coinciding with the national cervical cancer awareness week, the Medical Safari sought to provide free breast, prostate and cervical cancer screening services and create awareness on the risk factors, symptoms, prevention and importance of early and regular screening.

Other health services provided at the safari include; screening for diabetes and hypertension, eye care and free cataract surgeries, hearing aid services, orthopedic services, maternal check-ups, NHIF, Linda Mama and registration of differently abled persons to the National Council of Persons with Disabilities (NCWPD).

### **Medical Safari Round Up:**

During the launch of the Safari, the First Lady visited women undergoing fistula surgeries at Mama Lucy Hospital, where she gifted them with dignity packs. In addition, the First Lady officially opened the 'Kangaroo Mother Care Center' at the same hospital that will nurse preterm babies.

Further, the First lady launched the Nairobi County eMTCT Business Plan 2019 - 2022, aptly named "Tulinde kizazi jijini."



# 100 MEN RUN: #IWillRunForHer

This year, Valentine's Day was a little different with Beyond Zero bringing together 100 men in Karura Forest to run for women's health.

With a 5Km early morning run dubbed 'I will run for her', the aim was to raise awareness of men's engagement in maternal health.

This year the marathon had a new approach to engage with individuals and corporates during registration, and this was to select a "cause to run for" from the 9 Intervention areas as outlined in the Strategic Framework.


These were:

- Zero new HIV Infections
- A healthy Lifestyle for the Elderly
- Acceptability of Children who are Differently Abled
- Early screening for cancer
- Engagement of men in Maternal Health
- Zero Child Deaths
- Zero Child Marriages
- Zero Female Genital Mutilation
- Zero Maternal Deaths

Participants selected causes they resonated with as shown in the graph below;

The aim of selecting causes was to raise awareness of the different health issues that affect women and children and to spark conversations around those issues on how individuals and corporates can play a role in ensuring better health outcomes for women, and children.

Special Olympics was the latest addition to the race categories this year, a move guided by Beyond Zero's inclusion as outlined in its 2nd Strategic Framework.
